

A resolution by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas, canvassing returns and declaring the results of an election held in said City on this 8th day of August, 1992.

WHEREAS, this governing body ordained that an election be held within this city on the 8th day of August, 1992 for the purpose of and consideration of fourteen propositions for issuance of general obligation bonds, and consideration of two propositions concerning the issuance of revenue bonds and consideration of six propositions concerning the deauthorization of revenue bonds, and submission of a citizen petitioned initiative ordinance and consideration of a City Council alternative ordinance; and
