



Meredith Street Storm Drain Improvements

Lake Austin Watershed – Alternative 4

Alternative 4 Summary

Redirects a portion of the runoff, upstream of Meredith St. It will continue discharging into the cave, but with a significantly reduced flow. Rockmoor Ave. and Robinhood Trail will be used as routes to install new connections to an existing storm drain system.

Pros

Alleviates flooding at 3605-3607 Meredith Street.

Avoids the cave area, making it safer to construct.

Reroutes most of the runoff from the cave.

Cons

Long storm drain system.

Part of the runoff still goes into the cave.

Affects more residents during construction.

Estimated Cost

\$3 to \$4 million
